

The IOF Eventor Guide – Personal Photo

About the Guide

This guide is for all participants that are participating in IOF Events. The guide describes the purpose and characteristics of a good Personal Accreditation Photo for the roles:

- Team Athletes and Officials
- IOF Officials (Event Advising team; IOF Event Advisers, Jury)
- VIP: s (IOF Family, IOF Invited Guests etc)
- Media accredited persons
- Any athlete that want to show their photo together with their International results.

Photo purpose

The prioritized purposes are:

1. to be a formal accreditation card ID photo for IOF Events
2. to be used for TV graphics athlete presentations
3. to be used for media and followers
4. to be used for the -10 days public “Entered athletes and Team officials” report in IOF Eventor.

Photo requirements

- 4:3 proportion (4 Hight, 3 width)
- Size: 533*400 pixels
- File types: jpg; png
- Photo in color, in focus and good contrast.
- With a light background
- Photo taken directly from the face front. Upper part of chest visible (not only the face...)
- Athlete and Team Official Clothes: The preferred clothes are official federation team wear (track suit). Sponsors on official team clothing is permitted.

According to Foot Orienteering Competition rule:

33.2 Advertising on track suits or other clothing which are worn by team members during the official ceremonies shall not exceed 300 cm². There is no restriction to the amount of advertising on the runners’ competition clothing or equipment except for the start number bibs.

- No Headgear is permitted, except religious headgear if chin, forehead and both cheeks are clearly visible.

Upload Photo to IOF Eventor

You have three options to upload the photo

By yourself:

1. Login into IOF Eventor
2. Choose My Pages/Edit photo

- View public profile
- Edit profile
- Edit photo
- My events
- My Athlete Licences

By federation:

1. Federation admin login into IOF Eventor.
2. Select Administration/Federation members/Virtual login
3. Select “Your federation” in the Organization box
4. Select the “Athlete” (needs to be a “Member” of the Federation)
5. Select “Login as the above person”
6. Select “My pages” and upload photo
7. Log out

By IOF Office

Send photos, created according to the guideline and email to IOF Office. Name the photos with the correct IOF ID of the athlete. IOF Office then uploads the photo to the correct profile.
